

PIH Health Good Samaritan Hospital Visiting Hours



DECEMBER 31, 2021

We are committed to maintaining the highest safety standards.

Everyone will be screened (NOT TESTED) for COVID-19 and be required to wear a simple mask before being allowed to enter the Hospital. Masks will be discarded upon exit and a new mask reissued each time a visitor re-enters the building. Masks are to be worn at all times. All visitors must show acceptable proof of vaccination or proof of a negative SARS-CoV-2 (COVID-19) test within the last 72 hours.

Eating may occur only in designated eating areas and outdoor patios. No eating or drinking in patient rooms or common areas. The cafeteria is closed to all visitors at this time.

GENERAL HOSPITAL VISITING

- Visiting hours: 12 noon to 6 pm
- Two visitors per day
 - Visitors must remain in patient room throughout the visit

Exceptions

- Visitor of a patient whose death may be imminent
- Parent of a minor patient
- Support person of a laboring patient
- Support person of a disabled patient

COVID-19 patient rooms

- No visitors with exception of special circumstances

UNIT SPECIFIC VISITING

Critical Care Center

- Visiting hours: 12 noon to 6 pm
- Two visitors per day per patient for non-COVID-19 patients

Labor and Delivery/Postpartum Units

- Two support people may be present during the delivery and post-partum
- One support person allowed overnight

Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU)

- Visiting hours: 24/7 for parents of infant
- Two visitors at a time

Emergency Department (ED)

- One visitor per patient per patient stay

Acute Rehabilitation Unit (ARU)

- Visiting hours: 12 noon to 6 pm
- Two visitors per day per patient

Procedure and Surgical Visitors

- Two visitors per day per patient

Only those visitors accompanying patients or having other patient-related business will be granted access to the facility. All visitors must be 16 years of age or older.
