



## Downey Nursing Instructor Guideline for Students

The Downey Student Nurse Portal can be accessed using this link <https://www.pihhealth.org/about/downey-students/> You and your students will be able to view all videos and download all forms needed before your PIH Health Hospital Downey clinical assignment begins.

There are 5 eMD videos:

- Setting a Password in eMD
- eMD Basic View and Navigate
- Creating Patient Lists Downey
- eMAR Navigation and Documentation
- Student Nurse eMD Clinical Documentation

Your students will need to view each of these videos. The videos will take about 1 hour to watch. Once the videos have been viewed, the Student Nurse Check List will need to be completed.

*\*\* If you are unable to see ALL the videos (there are 5) please make sure Flash is enabled*

You and your students will be required to attend a 1hour 15 minute on-site training to the eMAR and documentation **PRIOR** to any patient assignments. You will be required to contact **DeAnne Christopher** in Education to schedule your time in the computer room. This should coincide with your first day, but may not always be feasible due to scheduling.

Also located on the portal are all the forms that will need to be completed and returned to the education department for each student:

- Nursing Student Orientation Packet
- Student Nurse Check List (acknowledgement that the student has watched the eMD videos)
- Unit specific Student Orientation
- Student Orientation Grid
- PIH Health Gait Belt & Restraint Competency

I hope this portal will make your student nurse orientation to PIH Health Hospital Downey a more convenient and efficient experience. Please be sure to complete all the above tasks with your students as soon as possible to ensure you have adequate time before your rotation in the event you run into any issues.
