WHAT IS THE FAMILY MEDICINE RESIDENCY CENTER?

Established in 1979, the Family Medicine Residency Center is the home of the Family Medicine Residency Program and a training site for 18 of our resident medical doctors who are in the process of receiving their Board Certification. This team serves more than 2,000 patients each month, supervised by faculty physicians. It is comprised of residents, registered nurse practitioners, physician assistants, health educators, social workers, dietitians and over 50 skilled staff members. All providers are well-versed in the latest medical treatments, using evidence-based care tailored to individual needs.

WHO ARE RESIDENT DOCTORS?

Resident doctors have completed medical school and have already obtained their medical degrees. They are in various stages of participating in additional clinical activities in order to expand their medical expertise.

WHAT ARE SOME BENEFITS OF THIS PROGRAM?

Because resident doctors' practices are bound by national guidelines, you may notice our residents spend more time with you or your loved one. In addition, every patient visit is reviewed and discussed with a supervising family medicine physician. Therefore, you may notice the supervising physician entering the room with your doctor to meet with you. This team-approach ensures you are receiving optimal care and simply doesn't exist in traditional physician offices.
