We are committed to maintaining the highest safety standards.

Everyone will be screened for COVID-19 and be required to wear a simple mask before allowed entrance. Masks will be discarded at exit and a new one issued at re-entry. Masks are to be worn at all times. All visitors must show acceptable proof of vaccination or proof of a negative SARS-CoV-2 test within the last 72 hours.

Gift Shop and Starbucks are open to patient visitors. Eating may occur only in designated eating areas, i.e., Starbucks and outdoor patios. The Cafeteria is closed to visitors at this time.

Visitors are limited from coming and going from patient rooms. Upon leaving, visitors may not re-enter until the next day.

Please note the temporary adjustments to our Visitor Guidelines.

General Hospital Visiting

- Visiting hours: 12 noon to 6 pm daily
- One visitor per patient, per day
 - » Two visitors may accompany patients for surgery or procedures regardless of time of day
 - » Exceptions will be made for special circumstances, such as end of life and/or disabilities that require additional support

Closed COVID-19 Units or Individual COVID-19 Patient Rooms

- No visitors with exception of special circumstances such as end of life

Critical Care Center

- Visiting hours: 12 noon to 6 pm daily
- One visitor per patient, per day, for Non-COVID-19 patients
 - » Visitors must check in with Main Lobby Receptionists to verify if patient is able to receive visitors

Labor & Delivery

- One coach/visitor may remain overnight, and are limited from coming and going from the department
- One doula per patient

Maternal Newborn

- One visitor may remain overnight and is limited from coming and going from the department

Neonatal Intensive Care unit (NICU)

- Two visitors with the same ID band as the baby allowed

Emergency Department and Infusion Center

- No visitors
 - » Exceptions will be made for minors, disabled adults and end-of-life patients

Transitional Care Unit

- Visiting hours: 12 noon to 6 pm daily
- Visitation by appointment only
- One visitor for one-hour visit per patient, per day
- Visitors must contact the TCU Front Desk at **Ext. 12543** to schedule a visit. Reservations are required
- A negative COVID-19 test will be required, further instruction will be given upon scheduling appointment

No Visitors Are Allowed in the Following Areas:

- Barlow Respiratory Hospital

Outpatient Services:

- One visitor per minor patient or patients needing physical, mental or language assistance in the following areas:
 - » Breast Health Center
 - » Cardiac Rehab
 - » Occupational Therapy
 - » Outpatient Imaging
 - » Physical Therapy
 - » Radiation Oncology
 - » Speech Therapy
 - » Wound Care Center
 - » Same Day Surgery
 - » GI Lab

Only those visitors accompanying patients or having other patient-related business will be granted access to the facility. All visitors must be 16 years of age or older.
