- **Blood Borne Pathogens Training** to be provided by University. (If applicable)
- **American Heart Association BLS CPR Card (front and back)** (If clinical assignment, check with your preceptor or instructor to determine if your discipline requires this)
- **Drug Screening: 9 Panel Urine Screen**
 1. Amphetamines
 2. Barbiturates
 3. Benzodiazepines
 4. Cocaine
 5. Marijuana Metab
 6. Methadone
 7. Opiates
 8. PCP
 9. Propoxyphene
 - Drug Screen may be done at HealthPointe
Cost is approximately \$35.00
 - Contact Diane Kennedy for authorization to HealthPointe
- **Record of immunization.**
- **Flu Immunization is required from October 1 to March 31.**
- **Tdap is recommended.**

Please note some County Health Centers may be providing the Tdap free of charge. PIH does not have this vaccine to provide to students.

- **TB skin test:** Annually. If Chest X-Ray: Within 90 days of first assignment. Annual visit to Employee Health if returning.
 - This may also be done at HealthPointe. Cost is approximately \$25.00
- **Background Check to Include:**

Office of Inspector General (OIG), **Criminal**, Social Security
