We are committed to maintaining the highest safety standards.

Everyone will be screened (NOT TESTED) for COVID-19 and required to wear a PIH Health-issued simple mask before allowed entrance. Masks are to be worn at all times. All visitors must show acceptable proof of vaccination or proof of a negative SARS-CoV-2 test within the last 72 hours.

Gift Shop, Jazzman's Cafe and Cafeteria are open to patient visitors. Eating may occur only in designated eating areas, i.e., Jazzman's, Cafeteria and outdoor patios.

Please note the temporary adjustments to our Visitor Guidelines.

General Hospital Visiting

- Visiting hours: 12 noon to 8 pm daily
- One visitor per patient, per day
 - » Exceptions will be made for special circumstances, such as end of life and/or disabilities that require additional support

Closed COVID-19 Units or Individual COVID-19 Patient Rooms

- No visitors with exception of special circumstances such as end of life

Critical Care Center

- Visiting hours: 12 noon to 8 pm daily
- One visitor per patient, per day, for non-COVID-19 patients
 - » Visitors must check in with Main Lobby Receptionists to verify if patient is able to receive visitors

Labor & Delivery

- One coach/visitor may remain overnight, and is limited from coming and going from the department
- One doula per patient

Maternal Newborn

- One visitor may remain overnight and is limited from coming and going from the department

Neonatal Intensive Care unit (NICU)

- One visitor with the same ID band as the baby allowed
 - » Only one person at a time may visit

Emergency Department and Infusion Center

- One visitor per patient, per patient stay

Acute Rehabilitation Center and Transitional Care Unit

- Visitation by appointment only
- One visitor for 30-minute visit per patient, per day
- Visitors must contact the ARC Front Desk at **Ext. 12525** or the TCU Front Desk at **Ext. 12543** to schedule a visit. Reservations are required

No Visitors Are Allowed in the Following Areas:

- Barlow Respiratory Hospital

Outpatient Services:

- One visitor per minor patient or patients needing physical, mental or language assistance in the following areas:
 - » Breast Health Center
 - » Cardiac Rehab
 - » Occupational Therapy
 - » Outpatient Imaging
 - » Physical Therapy
 - » Radiation Oncology
 - » Speech Therapy
 - » Wound Care Center
 - » Same Day Surgery
 - » GI Lab

Exceptions:

- Visitor of a patient whose death may be imminent
- Parent of a minor patient
- Support person of a laboring patient
- Support person for a disabled patient

Only those visitors accompanying patients or having other patient-related business will be granted access to the facility. All visitors must be 16 years of age or older.
